



## Week 11: Conversation around Investing

### Day 1:

Scripture Passage: 1 Peter 4:11

*Do you have the gift of speaking? Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. Then everything you do will bring glory to God through Jesus Christ. All glory and power to him forever and ever! Amen.*

- What gifts have you been given by God?
- How can you steward well what has been entrusted to you?

### Challenge:

- Take a spiritual gifts inventory today! Learn about your gifts and pray about ways to use them.

### Day 2:

Scripture Passage: 1 Timothy 6:6

*Yet true godliness with contentment is itself great wealth*

- Why is contentment so priceless?
- What do you need to keep at bay today so contentment is not compromised?

### Challenge:

- Ask for God's help in this area today -- write a list of all the things you are grateful for.

**Day 3:**

Scripture Passage: 1 Timothy 4:8

*Physical training is good, but training for godliness is much better, promising benefits in this life and in the life to come*

- How can you invest in your spiritual walk today?
- How does that investment influence the people around you?

**Challenge:**

- Memorize this verse today.

**Day 4:**

Scripture Passage: Colossians 3:23

*Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people*

- How can the work you do for God be seen as worship to God?
- Our service for God is an eternal investment, how can you keep that perspective?

**Challenge:**

- Examine your heart today -- where can work bring joy?

**Day 5:**

Scripture Passage: Galatians 6:7

*Don't be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant*

- Investment is sowing and reaping -- what are you planting in others to bless them?
- What does this Scripture promise? What does that mean to you?

**Challenge:**

- Pray and ask God to show you where to plant seeds of His love today.
