



## Week 8: Lesson 4 -- Called

### Day 1:

Scripture Passage: John 15:16

*You didn't choose me. I chose you. I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using my name*

- How does it feel to be chosen by God? How does that impact your calling?
- Knowing you are chosen by God brings empowerment and gratitude. Do you feel empowered and grateful? Are you living out your calling?

### Challenge:

- Take some time today to thank God for choosing you. Ask Him for the courage to live out your calling every day.

### Day 2:

Scripture Passage: Philippians 3:14

*I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us*

- Where could you use some encouragement today? Where do you need to "press on?"
- The hope of our heavenly prize is our eternal motivation -- this is not our forever home. How can you keep this in view today?

### Challenge:

- Take some time to encourage someone from your group today.

**Day 3:**

Scripture Passage: 1 Thessalonians 5:24

*God will make this happen, for he who calls you is faithful*

- Where do you need confidence to know and believe that God will make a way? How does His attribute of God's faithfulness help strengthen your faith?
- How does this truth build into your calling?

**Challenge:**

- Write out this verse on a post-it or put several reminders in your phone to keep it closeby today.

**Day 4:**

Scripture Passage: 2 Thessalonians 2:14

*He called you to salvation when we told you the Good News; now you can share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ*

- Our ultimate call is to salvation. Now, we get the opportunity to incorporate that in our daily lives and share with others -- who needs to hear the Good News about Jesus today?
- How can you share that with them today?

**Challenge:**

- Pray for an open door to share the Good News of God's love through Jesus Christ this week.

**Day 5:**

Scripture Passage: 2 Timothy 1:9

*For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus.*

- What distracts you from the calling of God to live a holy life? What challenges are you facing today?
- How does God's grace bring breath to you today? He enables us to live a life that brings Him glory.

**Challenge:**

- Take a deep breath today and thank God for His plan from the beginning of time.
