



## Week 9: Conversation around Calling

### Day 1:

Scripture Passage: Ephesians 4:4

*For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.*

- We have been called to one glorious hope. What is that hope? How does that bring joy to you today?
- Because of that truth; how will your day be different?

### Challenge:

- Be intentional today to see God in all things. At the end of the day, make a list of all the ways you experienced His presence.

### Day 2:

Scripture Passage: Exodus 9:16

*But I have spared you for a purpose—to show you my power and to spread my fame throughout the earth*

- What keeps you from living in your purpose? How can you keep perspective so that you continue to walk in God's purpose for your life?
- How can that impact the people around you?

### Challenge:

- Take some time today to give God your day and ask Him to direct your steps today.

### **Day 3:**

Scripture Passage: Proverbs 19:21

*You can make many plans, but the Lord's purpose will prevail.*

- Can you think of a time when you made plans, but God had different plans? What are some ways He is giving you more insight into His purposes for you?
- How do you find peace and courage to know you are in the right place at the right time to carry out your God-given calling?

### **Challenge:**

- Pray today about the calling and purpose He has designed specifically for you.

### **Day 4:**

Scripture Passage: 1 Peter 2:21

*For God called you to do good, even if it means suffering, just as Christ suffered for you. He is your example, and you must follow in his steps*

- Are you answering God's call on your life today?
- How are you following Christ's example in your current season of life?

### **Challenge:**

- Ask God for the courage to follow in His steps today.

### Day 5:

Scripture Passage: 1 Corinthians 13:7

Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

God's calling for your life involves love -- who is easy to love in your life right now? Who is difficult to love?

How can you keep your heart engaged in the calling even when it is challenging?

Challenge:

Reach out to someone who has been hard to love - buy them coffee, write them a kind note, and pray for them. Ask God to fill your heart with His love.
