1. Stephen Covey says, "Most people do not listen with the intent to understand; they listen with the intent to reply." How would you describe your listening skills?
2. Read **Hebrews 1:1-2**. How does the writer of Hebrews say God speaks? What are some things God has communicated to us through His Son?
3. Read **1 Samuel 3:1-11**. What did God do in this story? How did Samuel respond?
4. Share about a time in your life when you felt like God was trying to get your attention. How long did it take you to respond?
5. Read **John 10:3-5**. How do sheep respond to a shepherd's voice? Do you recognize God's voice? What are some "strange" voices that can distract you from following God?
6. Scott mentioned what his daily rhythm looks like. What does yours look like? If you don't have a daily rhythm, what keeps you from having one?
7. What can you do this week to make sure that you pick up your Bible and read it? What distractions do you need to get rid of?

Pray

Ask God to help you hear His voice. Pray that you will be obedient to what He calls you to. Pray that you will start to love the world the way that Jesus loves the world.
