1. Read **1 Kings 18:16-40**. What stands out to you about Elijah as you read this story again? King Ahab? The people of Israel? What do you learn about God?
2. Elton Trueblood describes the Christian faith this way, "Faith is not belief without proof, but trust without reservation." What's the difference? How did Elijah demonstrate trust without reservation?
3. Elijah stood alone against Ahab with a ton of confidence. Where might God be calling you to stand alone against the culture?
4. Israel had a choice between following the true God or serving Baal, a false god. What false god do you need to destroy, and what false prophet do you need to silence?
5. Read **1 Kings 18:26-29** again. Has chasing a false god ever completely exhausted you? Explain.
6. Have you ever been on a losing team before? What do you remember about that experience? Have you ever considered that you are on God's team, and He always wins?
7. How far will God go to let people know He always wins? How can you be part of His story?
8. Are you living a life that would be characterized as "humble and hungry?" What could that look like for you?

Read 1 Kings 18:36-39. Spend time praying boldly to God for the needs in your group. Ask Him to answer so that the world will know that He alone is God.
