Grow

1. Why do we see “the excluded being included” as a central theme in most Christmas stories?
2. **Read Luke 2:8-12.** How does telling the Shepherds about the birth of Jesus demonstrate that Jesus came for all?
3. Jesus came to save *everyone*. Do you believe that? Why or why not?
4. **Read Luke 2:17-18.** How did the shepherds respond? What might it look like if you were to respond to the news of Jesus’ presence in a similar way today?
5. The Christmas story shows Gods grace for us. Have you received Gods grace? If yes, take a moment to share your gratitude with God and another person. If not, will you ask Him to show you how to receive His grace today?

Pray

Ask God to help you respond to His grace. Pray that you will be empowered to show grace to others because God has shown it to you.
