

## To the Ends of the Earth: Week 1 — "Reaching the Unreached"

**CONNECT:** What is the most interesting or the furthest place you have traveled to?

## **GROW:**

- 1. Read through Matthew 28:16-20 together.
  - a. Although we aren't told, what do you think the disciples' initial response was to Jesus' words? Why was this commission so revolutionary? Why do you think Jesus said what He said in verse 20?
  - b. How has this verse impacted the way you live your life?
  - c. After reading through this scripture and listening to Sunday's message, in what ways do you feel challenged to live your life differently?
- 2. What stood out to you from the documentary about Mustard Seed's church planting initiative in Japan?
- 3. Read **Acts 1:8** and **Revelation 7:9-10** together.
  - a. What did Jesus' words in Acts 1:8 mean for the disciples, and what does it mean for us today?
  - b. We are living in between the moments in these two scriptures. How are you living out this mission to be a witness of Jesus locally, regionally, and globally? How do you feel challenged by this?
- 4. Read **Romans 10:14-15**. What are the most challenging parts about bringing the good news to people today? Do you feel equipped to share about Jesus with others? If not, what do you think would help you feel more equipped?

**NEXT:** What are some tangible changes you are going to make this week to share the good news of Jesus?

**PRAY:** Spend time praying for each other, and ask God for opportunities to share the good news of Jesus with someone this week. If you already have a person on your heart, be praying for them daily.
